ORDER OF SALE

The sale will commence at 10.00am with breeding cattle first, followed by young bulls and then store cattle; the younger ones being sold first followed by the older cattle.

TB TESTING

All vendors must sign a declaration confirming that if the cattle are over 42 days on the day of sale that they are either from a 3 or 4 year testing parish or if from a 1 or 2 year testing parish that the cattle have had a clear TB test within 60 days of the sale.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT ANY CATTLE WHICH NEED ANY ALTERATIONS ON THE PASSPORT. IF THERE IS AN INCORRECT SEX OR BREED, YOU WILL BE ASKED NOT TO BRING THE ANIMAL.

ALSO, ANY HAND WRITTEN NAMED SIRE'S WILL NOT BE DECLARED AND MUST BE OFFICIALLY PRINTED ON THE PASSPORT.

I.E. THE TAG NUMBER OF THE SIRE MUST BE PRINTED ON THE PASSPORT AND THEN THE NAME CAN BE HAND WRITTEN ON. BOTH ARE NEEDED TO BE OFFICIALLY DECLARED AND SOLD AS A NAMED SIRE.

NEW TB RULES FROM THE 1ST AUGUST 2023

If your farm holding is in an Edge or Low Risk Area then cattle purchased onto that holding from a high-risk area (as mapped at <https://tbhub.co.uk/>) must be Post-Movement Tested. I.e. Cattle must be Post-Movement tested 60 to 120 days after purchase on your holding. If your farm is in a High Risk Area then you don't need to post movement test. For more details, please speak to our Market Office

Customers selling Livestock at Leek Auctions must have fully completed movement forms which declare what TB-test interval takes place in your Parish so that we can pass this information onto the purchasers.
